

GED® Age Waiver Form

In order to write the GED® tests, individuals must be 19 years of age and not currently enrolled in an accredited high school program. The GED® Administrator™ is able to grant an exemption for an 18 year old to write the GED® tests if the individual has been out of school for at least one year and the individual's peer group has finished regular high school. An individual can request an age waiver by completing this form and sending it to the High School Certification Office by fax (709-729-0611), email (ronsmith@gov.nl.ca) or regular mail.
