English Second Language (ESL)

ESL programs are intended for students whose first language is not English and who are unable to benefit fully from regular classroom instruction because of a lack of comprehension or facility in English. The intent of this type of program is to enable these students to develop the necessary English language skills to function adequately in school and in the community.

Authorized learning resources for ESL are provided under the **Reimbursable Text Policy**. According to this policy, school districts are required to purchase authorized learning resources and submit copies of the **paid** invoices to the Learning Resources Distribution Centre. Resources that are available from LRDC are indicated.

ESL K-6

Resources for ESL K-6 may be ordered where there is an ESL teacher allocated.

Most Authorized Resources may be ordered for immigrant students in grades 3-6 who are functioning at a beginning to intermediate English level or who have major gaps in literacy achievement, regardless of whether there is an ESL teacher allocated. Children functioning at a beginning to intermediate English level would normally have had less than two years immersion in English.
