

World Geography 3202 - Update to June 2005 public examination

As you are already aware the World Geography 3200/02 Curriculum Guide was revised for this year. The guide has been posted on the Department of Education web site (http://www.gov.nl.ca/edu/sp/sh/soc_stu/world_geog/wg3200-3202aug04.pdf) and copies are available from the Learning Resources Distribution Centre. The public examination for June 2005 will be constructed based on this revised guide (see Table of Specifications, page 21).

There will be two parts to the Public Examination.

Part I

50 selected response items (50 marks)

Part II

Constructed response items (50 marks), including;

- three case studies
 - Two case studies covering the geographical themes of Physical and Economic Geography as defined by the concepts and outcomes in Units 1 - 5. Students will be expected to complete constructed-response questions based on both Case Studies.
 - The third case study will focus on Population and Urban Geography and students will be expected to answer constructed-response questions based on the unit they have studied.
- constructed-response questions that are independent of the case studies.
